In addition to the above cover, it should be noted that for exhibitions cover is provided where the expected attendance is less that 1,000 persons per day for indoor events and 1,500 persons pre day for outside events.

The title of the insurance is extended to include member's spouses/partners whilst such spouses/partners are temporarily acting for or on behalf of the Association of 16mm Narrow Gauge Modellers.

A claim will be invalid where it concerns a locomotive with a boiler capacity greater than 3 bar litres. It should be noted that for locomotives with a boiler capacity below 3 bar litre it is recommended that safety valves and pipework are tested and inspected annually.
